| <b>Issue:</b>                                   | This Moderator's Interpretation resolves two errors made in version 1, published on 16 February 2023:<br><br>1) In unit standard 29766, reference to the wrong Australian Training Standard.<br>2) Non-inclusion of unit standard 29767.<br><br>Guidance Information 1 in the current version of unit standard 29765 refers to Australian Training Standard <b>CPCDE3014A</b> .<br><br>Guidance Information 1 in the current version of unit standard 29766 refers to Australian Training Standard <b>CPCDE3015A</b> .<br><br>Guidance Information 1 in the current version of unit standard 29767 refers to Australian Training Standard <b>CPCBC4051A</b> .<br><br>The Australian Training Standards referred to in unit standards 29765, 29766, and 29767 <b>have been superseded</b> . Therefore, the equivalencies to Australian Training Standards noted in these New Zealand Unit Standards are no longer applicable. |
