Issue:	<ul> <li>This Moderator's Interpretation resolves an error made in version 1 of this unit standard, published on 26 October 2023.</li> <li>The inclusion of 'behavioural risks' in the range statement of Performance Criterion 1.1 has been challenged.</li> <li>1.1 Describe the physical health inequities for people experiencing mental health challenges or addiction issues.</li> <li>Range Māori, other ethnicities or communities; health inequities include – behavioural risks, health outcomes, healthcare access, life expectancy.</li> </ul>
Interpretation:	The inclusion of ' <i>behavioural risks</i> ' occurred during the RFI process when unit standard 33286 was with NZQA for listing. We have been informed that the term is meaningless and are happy to remove it from the unit standard.
Action Required:	Removal of <i>"behavioural risks"</i> from the range statement of Performance Criterion 1.1 in unit standard 33286.
Status	Effective 15 February 2024.
Resolution:	Providers assessing against this standard should ignore the compulsory <i>'behavioural risks'</i> range statement item. Unit standard 33286 will be resubmitted to NZQA to remove <i>'behavioural risks'</i> from the range statement of Performance Criterion 1.1.
Expiration:	On NZQA approval of the revised unit standard.
