Organisational requirements refer to the formal policies and procedures for a specific prison site and its activities, and which are consistent with its lead organisation.

- Prisoner needs or requests, decisions, and actions.
- Common changes in situation that impact on a prisoner's needs.
- At-risk behaviours for prisoner safety.
- Prisoner activity and identifying unacceptable prisoner behaviour.
- Services available to address or support prisoner needs.
- Professional presentation and manner with prisoners.
- Reinforcement of positive behaviour change.
- Feedback and guidance in support of rehabilitation activities.
- Documenting and communicating of prisoner care and rehabilitation needs.
