




About Toitū te Waiora

We help organisations make and teach *qualifications* for workers in






social services

People with these qualifications can be


Disability Support Workers

Why we need the new qualifications



The New Zealand Disability Support Network made a report after a review of health and wellbeing qualifications.



The report said qualifications must

 include information on life experiences of people who work in disability support



- give people the right skills for the job
 - for example, personal care skills



• teach everyone the same things.




The report also said many families and whānau have to give extra training to support workers.



This tells us the qualifications people get now, may **not** give people all the right skills for the job.
