Pārongo aromatawai me te taumata paearu | Assessment information and grade criteria

Assessment specifications:

- A minimum of 5 escorts must be undertaken prior to award of skill standard.
- Assessment must take place in the form of an external escort.
- Assessment criteria for safety and security requirements for emergency situations and/or incidents, may be scenario-based if the learner has not been involved in a prisoner escort emergency and/or incident.

Definition:

 A prison environment refers to a setting that replicates the conditions, structure, and dynamics of a correctional facility. This includes actual prisons, and any time prisoners are managed outside of the confines of a prison.

Ihirangi waitohu | Indicative content

- Escort documentation.
- Vehicle searches and checks before and after escort.
- Checking of safety equipment.
- Prisoner safety checks.
- Risk identification and communication to ensure safety and security during emergency situations or incidents.
- Communications with the prison.
- Handover of prisoner/s on completion of escort.
- Record and report escort information.
